

Airdrop Participation Checklist

Step 1: Set Up a Compatible Wallet

- Choose a wallet that supports the specific cryptocurrency of the airdrop.
 - Popular Wallets:
 - MetaMask (Ethereum-based tokens)
 - Trust Wallet (Multiple cryptocurrencies)
 - Coinbase Wallet
 - MyEtherWallet (MEW)
 - Binance Chain Wallet (BEP-2 and BEP-20 tokens)
 - Ledger Nano S/X (Hardware wallet)
 - Phantom Wallet (Solana)
 - Sollet Wallet (Solana)
- Install the wallet and securely store your private keys or seed phrases.

Step 2: Follow Official Social Media Accounts

- Identify the official social media accounts of the airdrop project.
 - Common Platforms:
 - Twitter
 - Telegram
 - Discord
 - Reddit
- Follow these accounts to stay updated on announcements and airdrop details.

Step 3: Complete Required Tasks

- Check the specific tasks required to qualify for the airdrop.
 - o Common Tasks:
 - Retweeting or sharing a post on social media
 - Joining a Telegram group or Discord server
 - Signing up for a newsletter
 - Holding a specific amount of cryptocurrency in your wallet
 - Filling out a participation form
- Complete these tasks as instructed and keep a record of your actions.



Step 4: Keep Track of Important Dates and Deadlines

- Note down key dates related to the airdrop.
 - Important Dates:
 - Start date of the airdrop
 - End date of the airdrop
 - Token distribution date
- Use a calendar or a tracking tool to set reminders for these dates.

Step 5: Verify Airdrop Legitimacy

- Research the airdrop project to ensure it is legitimate.
 - Verification Steps:
 - Check the project's official website
 - Look for information on reputable cryptocurrency forums or news sites
 - Verify the team behind the project and their previous work
 - Read community feedback on social media and forums
 - Avoid sharing private keys or seed phrases with anyone
- Only participate in airdrops from trustworthy sources to avoid scams
